

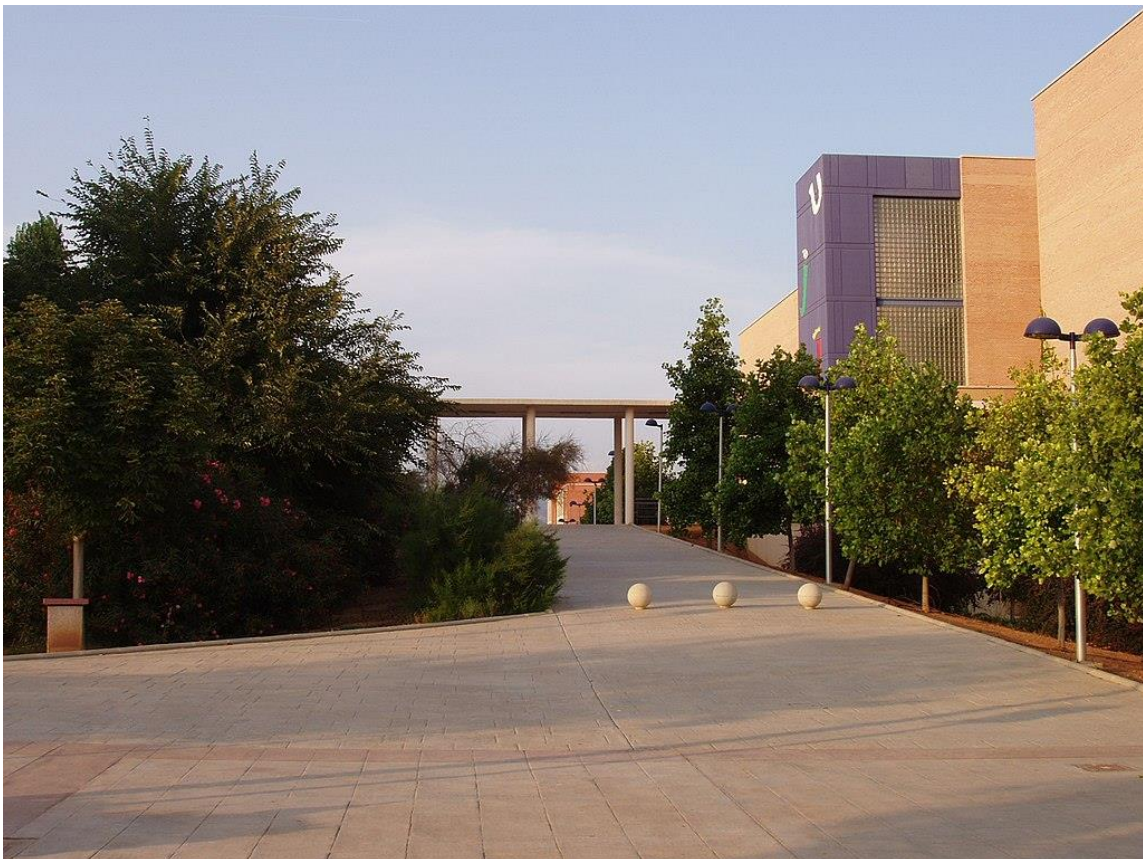

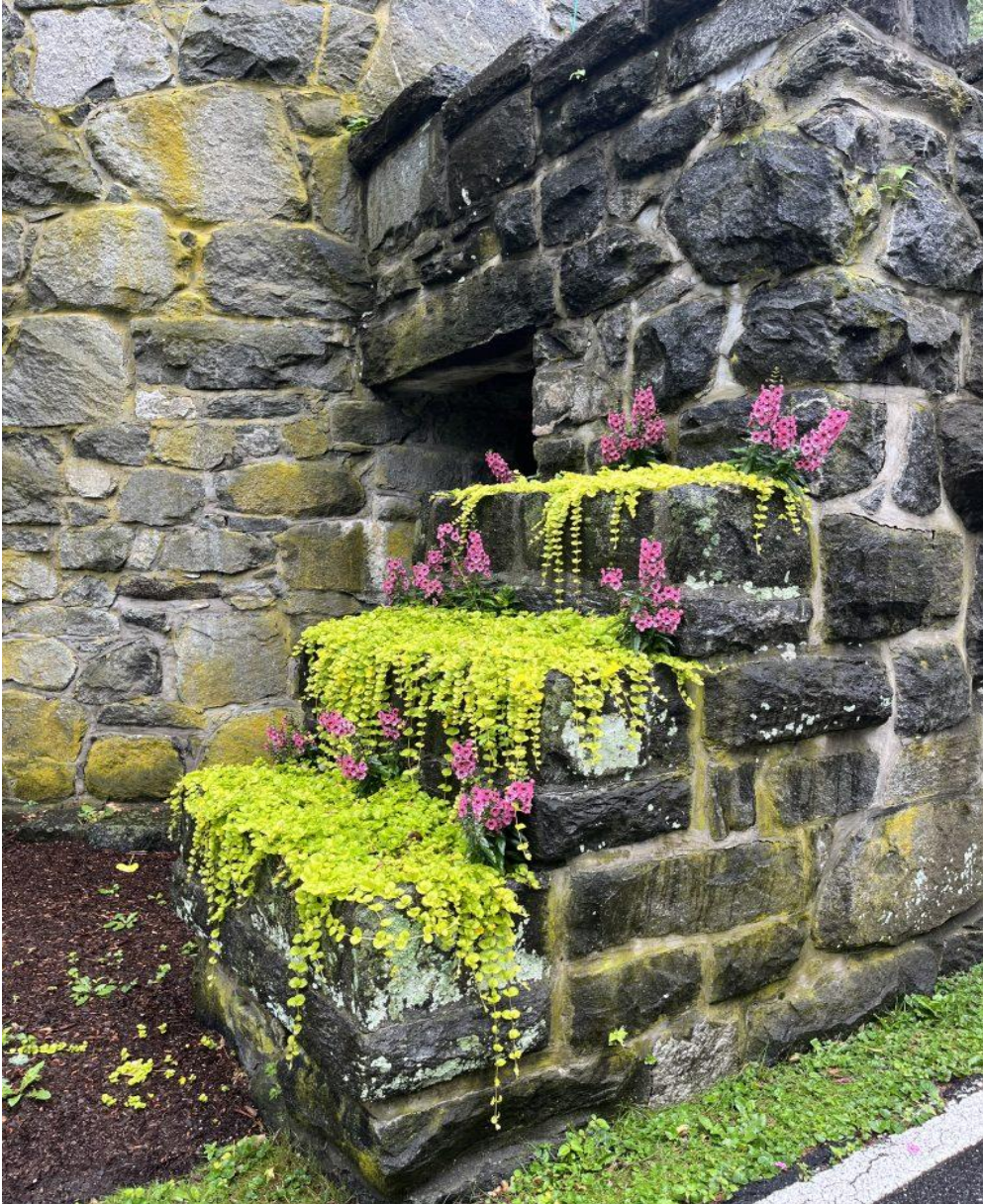
Cost of Attendance and Living

Endowment and Facilities

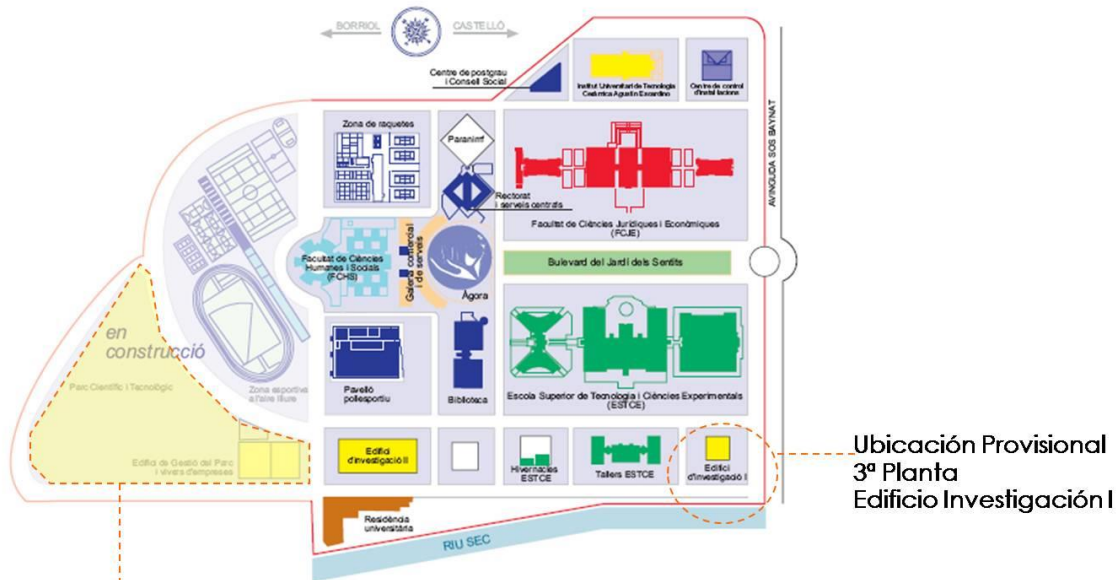
