


UNIVERSITAT JAUME I (www.uji.es)

It is a very safe city and much cheaper than larger capitals as Madrid, Valencia or Barcelona. It is one of the world's leading ceramic tile producers. It is perfectly located and very well connected by train: Madrid (2.5 hours), Barcelona (2 hours) and Valencia (1 hour).
